



2020-2021 WILLIAMSON COUNTY LIVESTOCK ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Scholarships will be awarded annually with amount varying each year. The number of scholarships awarded and the amount of each scholarship will depend on number of graduating seniors and availability of funds. Historically, in 2017 the WCLA awarded five \$1,000 scholarships; in 2018, the WCLA awarded eight \$1,000 scholarships.
2. Each student receiving a scholarship will be able to use monies at a college, university, or technical school of their choice regardless of location or major.
3. Eligibility:
 - a. Applicants must be:
 1. A graduating high school senior
 2. A member or previous member of a Williamson County, Texas 4-H / FFA club/program for at least one year;
 3. Involved in other community service projects and non-school activities.
4. All applicants must submit the following:
 - a. Typewritten Scholarship application
 - b. High School transcript
 - c. Letter of recommendation from:
 1. 4-H Leader/FFA Teacher (no more than two)
 2. Community or school leader (no more than three)
5. Scholarship awards will be announced in the spring or early summer prior to applicant's enrollment by the WCLA.
6. Before receiving scholarship, recipient must submit proof of school registration, social security number, name and address of financial aid office/director at school they will be attending. These items must be submitted 30 days prior to when recipient needs scholarship. All scholarship monies will be mailed directly to the financial aid office and will be distributed through them. Any monies left over or refunded will remain in student's scholarship account at school or be returned to WCLA.
7. The intent of the Williamson County Livestock Association Scholarship is to provide an equal amount award to qualified applicants, based upon the applicant's academics, extracurricular activities, involvement in the WCLA, and written application. Scholarship recipients shall be selected by a scholarship committee as appointed by the WCLA Board of Directors. The decision made by the WCLA scholarship committee will be final. Not all applicants will receive a scholarship. The amount of each scholarship awarded is in the sole discretion of the WCLA Board of Directors.
8. Money **must** be claimed within **six (6) months** of being awarded to recipient.
