- Late tag orders opened 9/12/21 and closed 9/25/21, no late fee.
- October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 last day for Validation, DNA packets must be returned to WCLA by 12 pm or postmarked on 10/2/21.
- Last chance validation to be located at back side of County Extension Office, 100
  Wilco Way, Georgetown, Tx 78626, from 8 am 12 pm on Oct 2, 2021. Must be in line by 11am.
- Market Rabbit tattoo evening of November 3, 2021 at back of County Extension Office.
- Breeding Rabbit completed via ShoWorks receipt; Upload tattoo info to ShoWorks?
- DNA packets collected and transmitted after receipt from exhibitor, AST's.
- Poultry re-band 14 days after pickup, any other poultry that loses band after the 14day grace period will not be allowed to show.
- Premise checks will happen this year for all validated animals.

Discussion on HB 3959 - Texas Youth Livestock Show Grant Program to be established by and administered by the governor.

Discussion on doing a Gun Raffle Fundraiser through the end of the year.

Sponsors: Mo Hamann - Discussion on Sponsors and donations. Holt Cat agreed to donate \$5,000 as Auction Sponsor.

Discussion on backdrop change and possible sponsors for backdrop. Mike Ondrasek in contact with designers and submitting for work up of backdrop and logo for 2021 show.

Awards: Blake Henderson has proof of buckles for review. Need to get orders in for rest of awards. Future feeder ribbon, etc. Reach out to buckle sponsor(s) and see if still on board this year to sponsor showmanship buckle(s).

Discussion about possibly moving Spring Fundraiser to a larger venue and a date in April.
 Need to check on available dates at different venues.

#### **New Business**

- 1) Broiler and tag orders went online and closed. Late tag orders were opened and closed this past Saturday, 9/25/21.
- 2) Late tag orders completed, need to finish distribution and will host last day of validation "catch all" on October 2nd from 8am 12pm behind the County Extension Office, 100 Wilco Way. Those coming to validation need to be in line by 11 am.
- 3) Our job/mission for validation is to help/teach AST's/CEA (4H) and exhibitors to self-validate. Not to do it 100% for them. The show rules state: "Validation in 2021 will be the responsibility of the Ag Teachers, 4H Leaders and Exhibitors. Exhibitors will be responsible for installing the tag and collecting the DNA sample."
- 4) Junior Director applications are out, due/postmarked on Sept 30th.
- 5) Need to get classifiers locked on for lambs, swine, and cattle. Need signed agreements back from judges we currently don't have.
- 6) Need announcer(s) for show-week, during the show.
- 7) Block off rooms for photographers, judges that have requested, etc.
- 8) Discussed on getting a list of judges for 2022 Show and getting commitments early next year to post early.

Discuss 2022 exhibitors will have an ethics form to fill out and animal location required with their validation packets. Location of animal projects not on a school or private grounds owned by exhibitor family will need approval.

Need to review Expo agreement, set up meeting at facility with Expo personnel. Clint Chitsey is leaving Expo, currently have opening for new Expo GM.

Need to revise scholarship applications for 2022 applying graduates for posting early in 2022 and award prior to end of school year. Amanda Doerfler and Heather Faske are currently redlining/revising the application.

Sponsors- Update from Mo or others? Maxwell Auto Group is going to be a \$5k sponsor.

Discussion on backdrop change. Discussed using top spenders from 2020 sale for 2021 backdrop, auction 4 sponsorships at spring fundraiser for 2022 show. Mike Ondrasek in contact with designers and submitting for work up of backdrop and logo for 2021 show.

Awards: Blake Henderson. Capital Farm credit agreed to be buckle sponsor for champion Showmanship buckles for 2021 show.

Discussion about possibly moving Spring Fundraiser to a larger venue, Wilco Expo Hall, on April. 9th, or 23rd. Only available dates are 9th, 16th, 23rd, the 16th is Easter weekend. Scott Heselmeyer made a motion to have fundraiser on April 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Wilco Expo Center and Richard Sells seconded, motion passed.

Distribution of Gun Raffle Fundraiser tickets to members who haven't received them.

Motion to adjourn by Richard Sells, seconded by Matthew Suchomel motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:10 PM.
