Old Business

- 1) Fundraiser Recap. Fundraiser was a success, total raised was \$59,108.85.
- 2) State Ethics Form/Housing Request information update via Shelley Franklin, CEA.
 - a) Breed Specific County-Level State Validation Committees
 - b) If an animal is not housed on either school or exhibitor’s property, must fill out a housing request form to be approved by state validation committee.
- 3) Discussion of breed/division champion buckles if they have a sponsor instead of just a rosette. Consensus of the group is to table discussion of adding more awards until next year. This years awards already ordered. Just completed spring fundraiser auctioning off grand and reserve buckles.
- 4) Revisit rulebook for 2022 to finalize. Closing of rulebook tabled until June.

New Business

- 1) Update of cattle show judge, Spencer Scotten is out due to judging HLSR. Skyler Scotten is the new Cattle Judge
- 2) DNA drawn on all state validated steers at time of state validation
- 3) Sent in order and question of buttons/backs for tags without number and only WCLA 2022. Still waiting to hear back.
- 4) Revisit rulebook for 2022 to finalize.
- 5) Motion made by Wayne Sanders to pay judges 62.5 cents per mile, or the current rate for travel and to pay species judges a fee of \$500 for poultry, rabbit, lamb and goat, and fee of \$750 for swine and cattle judges. Seconded by Mike Ondrasek. Motion passed.
- 6) Motion made by Wayne Sanders to close 2022 WCLA rulebook, Seconded by Mike Ondrasek. Motion passed.

Motion to adjourn made by Wayne Sanders. Seconded by Blake Henderson. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:49pm.
