Validation materials must be postmarked or turned in to the WCLA by 12 pm, on Saturday October 1, 2022 at the pavilion behind the County Extension Office, weather permitting. WCLA will have members there from 9 am to 12 pm for validation packet turn in and for those who need help validating. Those bringing animals to validate must be in line by 11 am.
